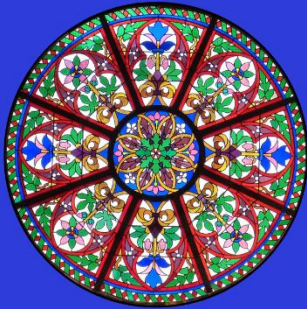
Coffee Hour Signup 4th Quarter Dates:
